AXIAL BACK PAIN - DISCOGENIC	Epidural Steroid Injection Provocation Discography requested by a surgeon	Referral for Surgery / Physical Therapy / Medications / Stem Cell Therapies
SIJ PAIN	SIJ Steroid Injections Diagnostic Lateral Branch Blocks	Radiofrequency Neurotomy (RF) Ablation of Facet Nerves, with the outcome of >50% pain relief in >85% patients, for >6 months. Procedure can be repeated after 6-12 months. PRP - Platelet Rich Plasma Injection - SIJ
AXIAL NECK PAIN / WHIPLASH INJURY / POST-OPERATIVE	Cervical Facet Joint Steroid Injection Cervical Facet Nerve Block - 1st Diagnostic Cervical Facet Nerve Block - 2nd Diagnostic	Radiofrequency Neurotomy (RF) Ablation of Facet Nerves, with the outcome of >50% pain relief in >85% patients, for >6-12 months. Procedure can be repeated after 6 months.
OCCIPITAL NEURALGIA / CHRONIC DAILY HEADACHE	Third Occipital Nerve Block (TON) - Steroid Injection C2/3 Facet Nerve Block - 1st Diagnostic C2/3 Facet Nerve Block - 2nd Diagnostic	Radiofrequency Neurotomy (RF) Ablation of third occipital nerves, with the outcome of >50% pain relief in >85% patients, for >6-12 months. Procedure can be repeated after 6 months.
NECK PAIN - RADICULAR PAIN (DUE TO DISC HERNIATION)	Epidural Steroid Injection (Interlaminar)	Spinal Cord Stimulation - Cervical Trial and Permanent Implant Placement
AXIAL NECK PAIN - DISCOGENIC	Epidural Steroid Injection Provocation Discography requested by a surgeon	Referral for Surgery / Physical Therapy / Medications
SPINAL STENOSIS WITH CLAUDICATION	Epidural Steroid Injection	MILD procedure for Ligamentum Stenosis (on hold). Referral to surgery.
AXIAL THORACIC PAIN DUE TO THORACIC FACET PAIN	Thoracic Facet Joint Steroid Injection Thoracic Facet Nerve Block - 1st Diagnostic Thoracic Facet Nerve Block - 2nd Diagnostic	Radiofrequency Neurotomy (RF) Ablation of Facet Nerves, with the outcome of >50% pain relief in >85% patients, for >6-12 months. Procedure can be repeated after 6 months.
RADICULAR THORACIC PAIN - POSTHERPETIC NEURALGIA POST-THORACOTOMY PAIN	Thoracic Epidural Steroid Injection	Spinal Cord Stimulation - Thoraco Lumbar Trial and Permanent Implant Placement
CHRONIC CHEST WALL PAIN DUE TO INTERCOSTAL NEURALGIA	Diagnostic Intercostal Nerve Block	Radiofrequency Neurotomy (RF) Ablation of Intercostal Nerves with long-term pain relief
CHRONIC KNEE PAIN DUE TO GENICULAR NEURALGIA	Diagnostic Genicular Nerve Block	Radiofrequency Neurotomy (RF) Ablation of Genicular Nerve (RFGN) with long-term pain relief
CHRONIC PAIN DUE TO ACHILLES TENDONITIS	Steroid Injection	PRP - Platelet Rich Plasma Injection
CHRONIC ELBOW PAIN LATERAL / MEDICAL EPICONDYLITIS	Steroid Injection	PRP - Platelet Rich Plasma Injection
HIP PAIN / TROCHANTERIC BURSTITIS	Steroid Injection	PRP - Platelet Rich Plasma Injection
